ADMISSIONS PROCESS

Step 1: The parent and/or guardian will submit a completed application to New England Academy.

Step 2: Upon receipt of the application and required materials the New England Academy admissions team will review the information. If upon initial review, the admissions team believes that the student referral meets the identified criteria, New England Academy's admissions coordinator will set up an interview with the student's parent(s) and/or guardian and the Executive Director.

Step 3: If the student appears to be an appropriate candidate for admission, the student will be invited to New England Academy for an interview. The student's interview will consist of the student meeting with a member of the leadership team (i.e. Executive Director, Dean of Students, Dean of Education, Dean of Clinical Services) to discuss with the student his/her educational goals, strengths and difficulties. Additionally, the student will have the opportunity to learn about New England Academy and to ask questions about the school.

Step 4: After meeting and interviewing the student, if the student appears to be a candidate for admission to New England Academy, he/she will be asked to come back to New England Academy for a school visit. During this visit, it is expected that the student will participate in classes, have an opportunity to meet staff and students and determine if the student believes that New England Academy is a good fit for them.

Step 5: Upon completion of the visit, New England Academy will make a final decision and contact the parent and student in regard to the student's acceptance or non-admittance.

Step 6: If the parent, student and/or school district agree with placement, a start date will be identified for the student and New England Academy will work closely with the parent on completing the enrollment packet.
